Investment Strategy

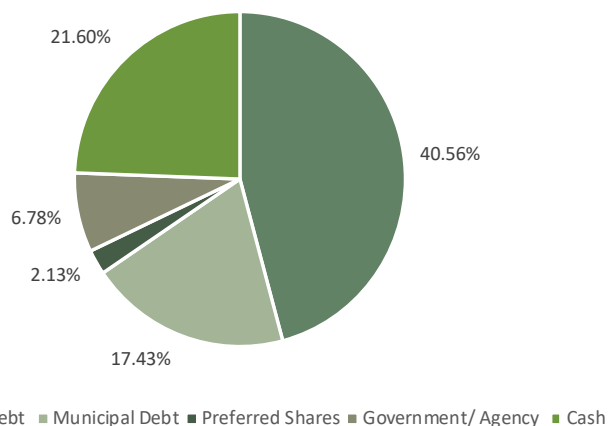
